IT'S TIME TO DEMAND ANSWERS!!!

This year, the New York State Education Department adjusted the state test scores to be set to the minimum standards for college readiness and the *scores took a nose dive for both district and charter schools across the city.*

- 42% of students citywide met standards in ELA, compared to 69% last year
- 54% of student citywide met standards in Math, compared to 82% last year
- The number of students way below standard (level 1) jumped from 12,000 to 63,000 citywide
- *The racial achievement gap is now as big or bigger than it was in 2003*
