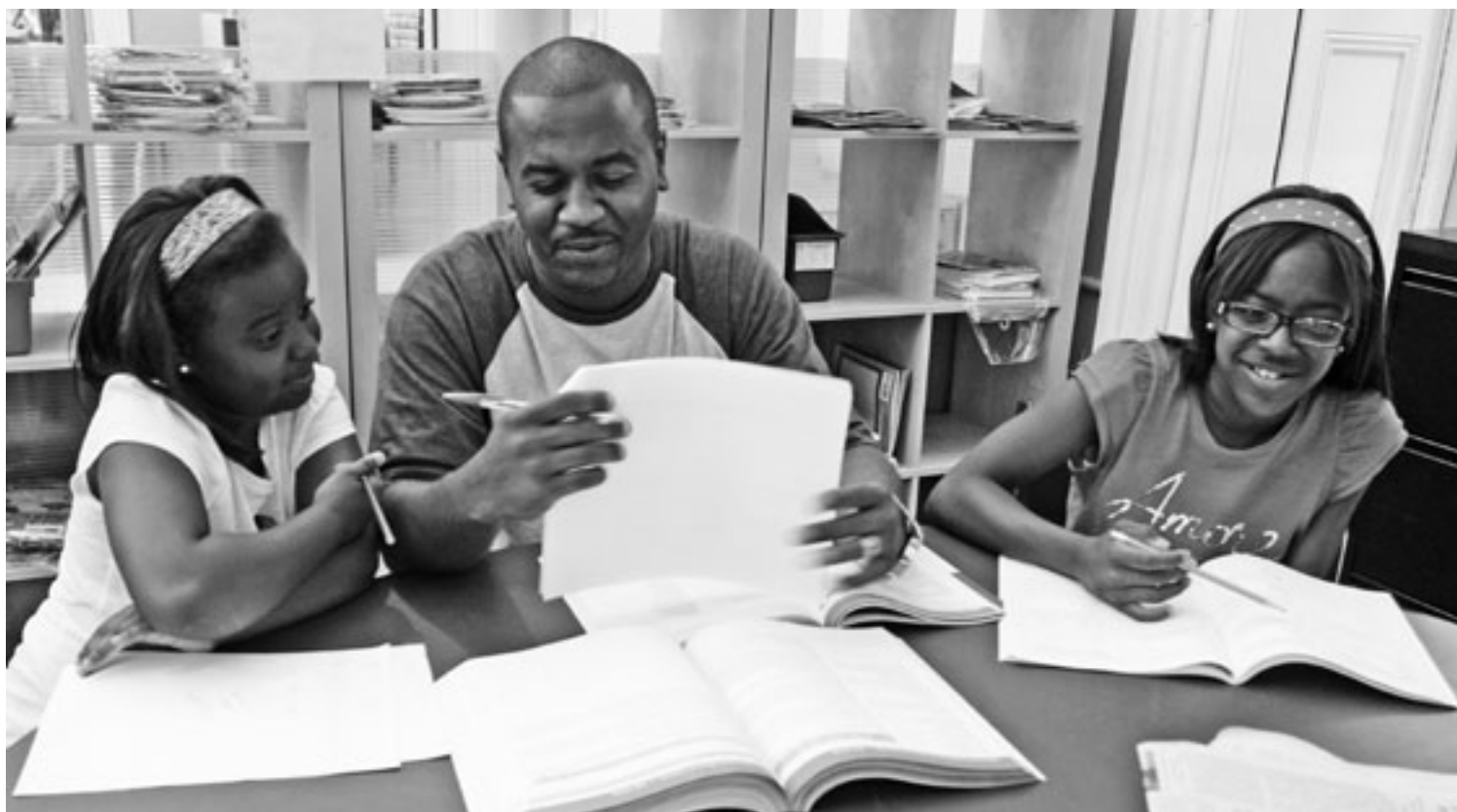


# Extended Parent-Teacher Conversations
